

Terms & Conditions

SKY RACING STAR STABLE

The Sky Racing Star Stable is an online fantasy stable of thoroughbred horses. The website www.starstable.com.au (the **Website**) and the Sky Racing Star Stable are operated by Vapormedia Virtual Sports, a business unit of Vapormedia Pty Limited ACN 095 684 067 (**Vapormedia**), for Sky Channel Pty Ltd ABN 77 009 136 010.

1. General Entry

- 1.1 Information on how to enter this Sky Racing Star Stable promotion (the **Promotion**) form part of these terms and conditions (the **Terms and Conditions**).
- 1.2 The promoter is Sky Channel Pty Ltd, 79 Frenchs Forest Road, Frenchs Forest, NSW, 2086, ABN 77 009 136 010 (referred to as the **Promoter** or **Sky Racing**).
- 1.3 Entry is open to all residents of Australia aged 18 years and over (the **Player(s)**).
- 1.4 By entering and/or participating in the Promotion, each Player agrees to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
- 1.5 Directors, officers and employees of, or contractors to, the Tabcorp Holdings Limited (**Tabcorp**) group of companies, their immediate families and all Tabcorp agencies and companies associated with the Promotion may enter the Promotion but will not be eligible to be awarded any prizes for participation in the Sky Racing Star Stable, including any Number 1 Club Reward points. For the purposes of these Conditions of Entry, "**immediate families**" means a spouse (including de facto), parent, sibling, child, grandparent, grandchild, or parent in law and includes stepparents and stepchildren and half siblings.
- 1.6 The Promotion is offered as a free game to all Players.
- 1.7 Sky Racing reserves the right to limit the number of Players in the Promotion at any time for any reason.
- 1.8 Any entry that fails to provide all required information may be disqualified. Sky Racing assumes no responsibility for incomplete, late or misdirected entries, or entries received through impermissible or illegitimate channels or for failed, partial or garbled computer transmissions, or for technical failures of any kind. Sky Racing reserves the right to disqualify any entrant submitting an entry which is not made in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who does not abide by the website Conditions of Entry.

Terms & Conditions

2. Term of Promotion

- 2.1 The Promotion will be based upon nominated race meetings between 10:00 AM (AEST) on Saturday 1 October and 11:59 PM (AEST) on Saturday 5 November 2011 (the **Promotion Period**).
- 2.2 The entry period is from 06:00 AM (AEST) on Monday 5 September 2011 to 10:00 AM (AEST) Saturday 1 October 2011 (the **Entry Period**).

3. How to Enter

- 3.1 To enter, Players must first, during the Entry Period, complete the online registration form located on www.starstable.com.au (the **Registration Process**). There are no charges for completing the Registration Process and all aspects of the Promotion are absolutely free. Members of the NSW TAB's Number 1 Club will receive 500 reward points for completing the Registration Process (where 1 Reward Point equals \$0.0025). The Reward Points will be deposited into the Player's Number 1 Club accounts on Monday 10 October, 2011. Reward Points can be redeemed for rewards and privileges through the Number 1 website-www.numberoneclub.com.au.
- 3.2 Once registered, Players will receive their personalised home page, where they are required to:
- (a) Choose a nickname, which is also used as their stable name (this name must not be offensive or otherwise objectionable or illegal, in Sky Racing's opinion);
 - (b) Participate in the selection of a fantasy 10 horse stable (**Stable**) and one stable jockey to the value of \$1,000,000 fantasy dollars;
 - (c) Play and maintain the Stable in accordance with these Terms and Conditions; and
 - (d) If they are invited to join a Mini League enter the appropriate details to join that Mini League. (A "Mini League" is a 'mini competition' within the overall promotion where friends, family and colleagues can set up their own individual competition and compete against each other.
- 3.3 Stables in the Mini League will score points as detailed in these Terms and Conditions.
- 3.4 Mini Leagues can be joined in one of two ways:
- (a) A Player can use the Mini League page on the Website to create and name a Mini League that other Players can be invited to join. The Player will be included in that Mini League.

Players invited by another Player to join a Mini League will receive an invitation and link to the registration page on the Website for the Sky Racing Star Stable game and once registered, will be automatically added to the Mini League.

- (b) A Player can accept an invitation from another Player to join their Mini League using a syndicate code that will be sent to them.

Players can only enter the Promotion once per email address.

3.5 Mini-Leagues for a TAB Outlet - **limited to participating TABs only**

- (a) A TAB Agency may choose to run for its customers a mini-league (known in this clause 3.5 as the **Local Store Competition**).
- (b) TAB Agencies that run a Local Store Competition will have an in-store leader board, which will be displayed inside the TAB Agency and maintained over the course of the Promotion by their staff.
- (c) Each Local Store Competition will have its own unique Mini League code, and customers may enter a participating Local Store Competition in the same manner a Player enters a Mini League as per clause 3.4 above.
- (d) Players are limited to entering one (1) Local Store Competition for the Promotion.
- (e) The winner of a Local Store Competition will be the Player in that particular Local Store Competition that has scored the most Credits in accordance with these Terms and Conditions at the end of this Promotion.
- (f) In the event a Player enters more than one (1) Local Store Competition, and wins more than one (1) Local Store Competition, that Player will only be eligible to receive the prize for the Local Store Competition they entered first, and the prize for the other Local Store Competitions will be awarded to the Player who is the next highest scorer in that particular Local Store Competition.
- (g) Local Store Competition winner's will be announced on Monday 7 November 2011 at the respective participating TAB Agencies (the **Local Store Prize Determination**).

- (h) TAB Agencies participating in the Local Store Competition will be clearly marked in-store with signage and prize value. Ask at your local TAB if they are a participating TAB Agency and for further details regarding their Local Store Competition.
- (i) The Player must have completed the Registration Process and also have registered through the 'local league' function on the Website in order to be eligible to enter the Local Store Competition.
- (j) Subject to any conflict with this clause, the Terms and Conditions of the Promotion otherwise apply to Players entering a Local Store Competition, including Clause 13.5.
- (k) A winner of a Local Store Prize Determination will receive the prize specified for that particular Local Store Competition.
- (l) Clauses 7-11, (excluding sub-clauses 8(b)-(h)) of these Terms and Conditions apply to each winner of a Local Store Competition, with:
 - (i) the reference to Prize being a reference to the prize awarded for the Local Store Prize Determination; and
 - (ii) A reference to either "Winner" or "Minor Prize Winner" being a reference to the Local Store Competition winner;
- (m) If a Local Store Competition prize is not claimed within three (3) months after the Promotion, subject to clause 4.5(f) above, the prize will be awarded to the Player which finished in second position in the Local Store Competition. This will take place at 10:00 AM (AEST) on Tuesday 7 February 2012 at Sky Channel Pty Ltd, 79 Frenchs Forest Rd, Frenchs Forest, NSW, subject to any written directions (the **Unclaimed Local Store Prize Determination**).

4. Game Rules and Scoring

4.1 Stable

- (a) Players must select a stable of 10 different thoroughbred horses (each a **Horse**) from a pool of Horses (**Stable**) determined and ranked by Sky Racing experts (**Pool**). Each Horse will be categorized and given a dollar value. The Promoter may choose to add Horses to the Pool at its discretion.
- (b) A Stable is limited to a maximum value of one million dollars (\$1,000,000).

Terms & Conditions

- (c) At specified times during the Promotion Period, a Player may vary the composition of their Stable in accordance with these Terms and Conditions (see clause 4.4 – Trades).

4.2 Races

- (a) The Promotion will feature 84 scoring races (**Featured Races**), to be split into 9 separate race meetings (**Race Meetings**).
- (b) Each Stable will receive a virtual credit (**Credit**) equal to the dollar value of the prize money awarded to a Horse in that Stable if that Horse wins or runs a place in a Featured Race throughout the Promotion Period.
- (c) For all meetings, Stables will be credited with the dollar amount awarded by the race clubs on all Featured Races conducted during the Race Meeting (number of races per meeting detailed below).
- (d) The dollar value is the amount of actual prize money awarded and does not include the value of BOBS, VOBIS incentives, trophies or rugs.
- (e) Following each of Race Meetings, scoring updates will be posted on the Website setting out the number of dollars credited to each Horse and each Stable's progressive total.
- (f) In the event that a Player's Horse is scratched from one of the Featured Races, Players are not entitled to replace the Horse in that race (unless they are able to make a trade in one of the Trade Periods).
- (g) In the event of a dead heat for any of the positions that attracts prize money, the Stable will be allocated credit equal to the final prize money that the race club allocates to that position.
- (h) If a Race Meeting is abandoned or cancelled no credit allocations will be made.
- (i) If additional races are scheduled on any of the below ten race days, they will be included in the Promotion and will become Feature Races. The number of Featured Races at each Race Meeting is correct as at 26 May 2011.

4.3 Stable Jockey

- (a) Sky Racing will select a pool of jockeys that will ride during the Promotion Period. Players must select one (1) jockey to accompany their Stable. If the Player's Stable jockey wins one of the Feature Races, the Stable will receive a one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) bonus Credit per race (the **Jockey Bonus**).
- (b) Note: the Jockey Bonus is based on the Player's selected jockey performance and not on the performance of their Stable of Horses.

4.4 Trades

- (a) There will be seven (7) periods (**Trade Periods**) during the Promotion Period (see details of dates below) where Players can modify their Stable of Horses (**Trades**). Players can trade no more than two (2) Horses per Trade Period and cannot accumulate Trades from one Trade Period to the next. Players can also make one (1) jockey trade per Trade Period.
- (b) Each Trade Period allows a Player to exchange two (2) Horses and one jockey in their Stable with a horse and jockey from the Pool (which is not already in the Player's Stable). Trades take effect prospectively, i.e. for Featured Races still to be run at the time of the Trade.
- (c) Each Stable must retain the stipulated stable number of horses (10 horses), and remain within their one million (\$1,000,000) budget at all times.
- (d) There will be 7 Trade Periods over the course of the Promotion Period. Below outlines opening and closing times of each Trade Period.

5. Selection of Winners

5.1 Major Prize

- (a) At the completion of the Promotion, the Stable that has been awarded the highest aggregate Credit during the Promotion Period will be declared the winner (the **Major Prize Winner**). The Major Prize Winner will be determined by the Promoter at Sky Channel Pty Ltd, 79 Frenchs Forest Rd, Frenchs Forest, NSW, at 10:00 AM (AEST) on Monday 7 November 2011 (the **Major Prize Determination**).
- (b) In the event of a tie, the Stable with the highest number of first-place finishes will be declared the Major Prize Winner. Should this fail to break the tie, the Stable with the highest number of first and second place finishes will be declared the Major Prize Winner. Where a tie cannot be resolved by any of the means above, the Player whose Star Stable entry was registered the earliest in time will be declared the Major Prize Winner.

5.2 Minor Prizes

- (a) There will also be weekly minor prizes awarded (the **Minor Prize(s)**).
- (b) At each Weekly Prize determination (the details of which are provided in clause 5.2 (c) below) the Player (the **Minor Prize Winner**) that was awarded the most Credit (when compared to other Players) over the preceding week will be determined and will receive the Weekly Minor Prize (as detailed in clause 6.1 (b) below).
- (c) The winners of the Minor Prize will be determined by the Promoter weekly at 10:00 AM (AEST) on each of Monday 3 October 2011, Monday 10 October 2011, Monday 17 October 2011, Monday 24 October 2011, Monday 31 October, and Monday 7 November (each a **Weekly Prize Determination**) at Sky Channel Pty Ltd, 79 Frenchs Forest Rd, Frenchs Forest, NSW.

- (d) In the event of a tie, the Stable with the highest number of first-place finishes will be declared the Minor Prize Winner. Should this fail to break the tie, the Stable with the highest number of first and second place finishes will be declared the Minor Prize Winner. Where a tie cannot be resolved by any of the means above, the Player whose Star Stable entry was registered the earliest in time will be declared the Minor Prize Winner.
- (e) Minor Prize Winners will be notified by phone and/or email by 06:00 PM (AEST) on the day of the respective Weekly Prize Determination.

6. Prizes

6.1 There is one Major Prize and seven (7) Minor Prizes (collectively referred to as **Prizes**).

(a) **Major Prize**

1st Prize: The Player who manages the Stable that has been awarded the most Credit during the Promotion Period will win:

- (ii) \$500 TAB Fixed Odds Win bet placed on their horse each time it runs (capped at 12 runs a year for 2 years) If TAB Fixed odds not available the bet will be placed via the NSW TAB Tote. Bets will be placed by Tabcorp on behalf of the winner. Maximum value: \$12,000
- (iii) Early morning trackwork to watch the horse in training at Royal Randwick Racecourse followed by breakfast at Bills in Surry Hills with the horse trainer, John O’Shea, and Andrew Bensley for you and a friend. (Date to be confirmed with the winner at the

time they win the prize).

- (iv) Flights to Sydney from the winners home state on the day before the confirmed trackwork, and flights returning back to the winners home state.
- (v) One night accommodation at Crowne Plaza Coogee on the night prior to the trackwork
- (vi) Transfers from Sydney airport to Crowne Plaza Coogee, Crowne Plaza Coogee to Royal Randwick racecourse, from Royal Randwick Racecourse to Bills in Surry Hills, back to Sydney airport.

Total Maximum Major Prize Pool: (With the horse running 12 times per year): \$17,650

Total Minimum Major Prize Pool: (If horse runs 0 times per year): \$5,650

(b) Minor Prizes

At each Weekly Prize Determination, the Player that was awarded the most Credit (when compared to other Players) over the preceding week will be determined and will receive:

- If NSW TAB Account holder:
 - Forty thousand (40,000) Number 1 Club Reward Points (where 1 Reward Point equals \$0.0025). Reward Points can be redeemed for rewards and privileges through the Number 1 Club website - www.numberoneclub.com.au to be deposited in the Player's Number 1 Club account within 7 days of the Weekly Prize Determination; and
- If not a NSW TAB Account holder:
 - One hundred dollar (\$100) cheque to be sent to the Player within 21 days of the Weekly Prize Determination.

7. Costs

Terms & Conditions

All other costs associated with the Prizes, including but not limited to any meals (not specified), taxes, insurance, and other ancillary costs are the responsibility of the Prize winners.

8. Prize Specific Conditions

- (a) All Prizes (both Major and Minor) are inclusive of GST and Sky Racing takes no responsibility for any variations in the value of the Prize.
- (b) The Major Prize Winner will not pay any costs until 30 June 2013.
- (c) **From 30 June 2013 the Major Prize Winner will be responsible for all costs associated with their share of the horse.**
- (d) The Major Prize may not be transferred or registered in any third party name.
- (e) All prizemoney earned by the horses will be distributed to shareholders directly from Racing NSW or the appropriate racing body, according to pro rata shareholdings, directly into each syndicate owners nominated bank account. The racing body distributes 85% of prizemoney earned to owners after providing 10% to the trainer and 5% to the jockey. Trophies won will be allocated out to one owner based on a ballot basis of those who wish to participate and their ownership percentage. Should several owners want a copy of the trophy it may be necessary for those shareholders to purchase replicas for the amount required and the cost averaged between shareholders who want a trophy.
- (f) The Major Prize Winner will be required under ASIC law to complete a Share Application Form attached to a Product Disclosure Statement and Financial Services Guide. This set of documents acts as the Partnership Agreement and establishes the requirements of each partner and the working structure of the partnership.
- (g) As horse racing is of a highly speculative nature, no warranties can ever be implied or given by any party as to racetrack success of any thoroughbred. The Promoter makes no representations concerning the value, state or condition of the horses. The Major Prize Winner releases and discharges the Promoter from any claim to the contrary.
- (h) The winner will be fully briefed and given advice on the procedure for selling their shares in their racehorse, should they choose to sell their shares from 30 June 2013.

Terms & Conditions

- (i) If Prizes are unavailable, for whatever reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the Prizes for Prizes of equal or greater value, subject to state regulation.
- (j) All Prizes must be taken as offered and cannot be varied.
- (k) All Prizes must be taken on the dates specified only and cannot be transferred.
- (l) In the event that for any reason whatsoever the Major Prize winner does not confirm acceptance of the Major Prize by phone or email within three (3) months of the Prize Draw, cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the Major Prize and a re-draw will be conducted in accordance with clause 14.
- (m) Unless otherwise advised in these Terms and Conditions, all other costs associated with the redemption of the Prizes are the responsibility of the Prize winners.

9. Major Prize Winners Notification

- 9.1 The Major Prize Winners will be notified by phone and in writing, using the details provided in their entry. The winners name and suburb will be published on the Star Stable website (www.starstable.com.au). And in the in the Australian on Friday 11 November 2011.
- 9.2 The Minor Prize Winners will be notified by phone and in writing, using the details provided in their entry by 6:00 PM (AEST) on the Monday of their respective Weekly Prize Determination.

10. Tax Statement

Any taxes which may be payable as a consequence of the Winner receiving the Prizes are the sole responsibility of the Winner. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from the Prize winnings. Independent financial and tax advice should be sought.

11. Exclusion of Liability

- 11.1 While the Promoter will use all reasonable endeavours to arrange the delivery of the Prizes by the times detailed in these Terms and Conditions, by entering this Promotion, Players acknowledge that circumstances beyond the control of the Promoter may prevent the delivery of the Prize by that date, or at all (including the failure by the Player to notify the Promoter of any change of delivery address or the closure of the Player's NSW TAB account). In such

circumstances where the Promoter forms a reasonable belief that any delay or loss of the Prize has not been caused or contributed by the Player's negligence, fraud, misconduct, the Promoter may (if circumstances permit) re-deliver the Prize to the Player.

- 11.2 To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss, including, but not limited to, direct, consequential (including economic) or indirect loss or any loss of profits, by reason of any act or omission, deliberate or negligent, by the Promoter or their servants or agents, in connection with this Promotion or the arrangement for supply, or the supply or failure to supply, of any goods or services by any person to a Player or a Prize winner.
- 11.3 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions affect, nor is intended to affect, any rights that a Player might have that are not able to be excluded under applicable Australian consumer protection laws.

12. Use of Personal Information / Marketing

- 12.1 The Promoter complies with the National Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).
- 12.2 Any entries become the property of the Promoter. Any information Players provide will be used by the Promoter for the purpose of conducting this Promotion.
- 12.3 The Promoter may disclose Players' personal information to its contractors and agents to assist in conducting this Promotion or communicating with Players.
- 12.4 By entering the Promotion, Players consent to their personal information being collected, used and disclosed by the Promoter, its agents, affiliates, related business companies, other companies associated with this Promotion, and business partners for any promotional activities, including the Player's personal participation in reasonable promotional activities as requested by the Promoter, and any marketing and publicity purposes without any further reference, payment or other compensation to the Player.
- 12.5 Players' consent includes authorising the Promoter, its agents, affiliates, related business companies, other companies associated with this Promotion and business partners to send the Player future electronic messages including but not limited to, SMS, MMS, and email regarding any promotional, marketing and publicity activities.
- 12.6 Players' personal information may be disclosed to State and Territory lottery departments and winners' names published as required under the relevant lottery legislation. The Promoter will use reasonable endeavours to provide the Player reasonable prior notice where their personal information is going to be disclosed to State or Territory lottery departments or published under lottery legislation. A request

to access, update or correct any information should be directed to the Promoter at its address set out in clause 1.2.

- 12.7 All Players consent to the publication of their name and suburb of residence (however their full address will not be published) and agree to participate in reasonable Promotion activities as requested by the Promoter.
- 12.8 For more information, refer to the Promoter's Privacy Policy located on the Promoter's website, www.skyracing.com.au.

13. General Conditions

- 13.1 The Promoter, its employees, officers, agents, and its parent companies and subsidiaries are not responsible for and shall not be liable for:
- (a) any condition caused by events beyond the control of the Promoter that may cause the game to be disrupted or corrupted;
 - (b) any injuries, losses (including, without limitation, loss of profits), or damages of any kind (even where resulting from negligence of the Promoter or any other person) caused by the Prizes or resulting from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of the Prizes, or from participation in the Promotion or downloading material from the Website; or
 - (c) any printing or typographical errors in any materials associated with the Promotion.
- 13.2 The Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to:
- (a) cancel or suspend the Promotion, should the security, fairness, integrity, or proper operation of the Promotion be compromised in any way by any virus or bugs in the IT system used for this Promotion; unauthorised human intervention, or other causes beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter;
 - (b) disqualify any Player who engages in offensive, illegal or objectionable conduct;
 - (c) disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, or who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions;
 - (d) cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion in accordance with any written directions given by any relevant government or regulatory authority to do so;

- (e) request the winner provide proof of age, identity or proof of residency at the nominated Prize delivery address.
- 13.3 In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the event and recommence it from the start on the same conditions subject to State Regulation.
- 13.4 It is a condition of accepting the Prizes that the Winner may be required to sign a legal release in a form determined by the Promoter and agreed to by the Player, acting reasonably.
- 13.5 To the extent that a situation or issue arises for which these Terms and Conditions make no provision or in relation to which the relevant Terms and Conditions are unclear, the Promoter will make a decision regarding such situation. The Player will have the right to request an internal review of the Promoter's decision. Subject to any regulator direction to the contrary, the decision of the internal review will be final and binding.
- 13.6 In the event that a Player is identified as a minor, self excluded patron, involuntarily excluded patron or any other person who is in breach of these Terms and Conditions, the Promoter reserves the right to refuse to allow the Player to take part in, or receive, any or all aspects of the Prizes, and the Promoter will notify any relevant regulator accordingly where required by law to do so. In such circumstances, a re-draw may occur.
- 13.7 Decisions of the management of the Promoter are final. No correspondence will be entered into.

14. Unclaimed Prize Determination

- 14.1 If the Minor Prizes are not claimed within three (3) months after the Minor Prize Draw, the Minor Prize will be awarded to the Player which finishes in second position for that week.
